ORDINANCE No. 2016-01

**AN ORDINANCE REVISING A "NO PARKING ZONE" ON S.R. 0174 PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BY
ORDINANCE 1975-15**

WHEREAS, the Township of South Middleton is a Local Authority, under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended (75 Pa.C.S.A. 101, et seq.) having certain roads or highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Township of South Middleton is authorized under Section and 6109 (a)(1) of said Vehicle Code to regulate or prohibit stopping, standing, and parking on said roads; and

WHEREAS, the Township of South Middleton adopted Ordinance 1975-15, establishing a "No Parking" zone on the northern side of S.R. 0174 (First Street) from the intersection of the northern right-of-way line of S.R. 0174 with the eastern right-of-way line of S.R. 2037 (Forge Road) for a distance of 350 feet eastwardly; and

WHEREAS, it is the Township's desire to revise said "No Parking" zone to reduce the distance from 350 feet eastwardly, to 80 feet eastwardly; and

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors in and for the Township of South Middleton, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1 – "No Parking" zone revised

The "no parking" zone established by Section I of the ordinance adopted by the Board of Supervisors on April 3, 1975 (*Ordinance No. 1975-15*), is hereby revised as follows:

The north side of S.R. 0174 (First Street) from the intersection of the northern right-of-way line of S.R. 0174 with the eastern right-of-way line of S.R. 2037 (Forge Road) for a distance of 80 feet eastwardly is hereby designated a "No Parking" zone.

SECTION 2 – Severability

In the event any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, it being the intent of the Board of Supervisors that the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in their full force and effect.

SECTION 3 – Repeals


All Township ordinances, resolutions, policies, and regulations, or parts of ordinances, resolutions, policies, and regulations, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4 – Effective Date


This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with existing law.




