ORDINANCE NO. 99-20

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ESTABLISHING  
A "NO PARKING" ZONE  
ON PETERSBURG ROAD PA. ROUTE 2001 (SR2001),  
SOUTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP

**WHEREAS**, IT HAS COME TO THE ATTENTION OF THE Board of Supervisors that vehicular parking along a certain portion of Petersburg Road (SR 2001) creates a dangerous situation to both vehicular and pedestrian traffic and has become an impediment to the free flow of traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, PADOT has indicated approval of traffic restrictions along Petersburg Road;

**IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of South Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

Petersburg Road (SR2001) from the intersection of Westminster Drive (T-456) to the intersection with Meals Road (private) along both right-of-way lines is hereby designated a "No Parking Zone".

**SECTION 2.**

Any person or persons, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon summary conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-five (25.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (100.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution, which fine and costs shall be recoverable as debts of like amount are by law recoverable.

**SECTION 3.**

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any other remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision not been included therein.
