ORDINANCE NO. 75-15

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ESTABLISHING A "NO PARKING" ZONE ON PA. RT. 174 (L.R. 21009), BOILING SPRINGS, SOUTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of South Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I: The North side of Pa. Rt. No. 174 (L.R. 21009) from the intersection of Northern right of way line of Pa. Rt. No. 174 (L.R. 21009) with the Eastern right of way line of L.R. 21008 (Forge Road) for a distance of 350 feet Eastwardly is hereby designated a "no parking zone."

SECTION II: Any person or persons, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon summary conviction before a District Justice be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Two (\$2.00) Dollars, nor more than Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution, which fine and costs shall be recoverable as debts of like amount are by law recoverable and in default of payment of said fine and costs, shall be committed to the Cumberland County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION III: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any other remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision not been included therein.
