PROJECT OVERVIEW

South Middleton Township is currently completing development of a master plan for 3 adjacent parks on Park Drive. The purpose of the master plan is to establish a long-term vision for development of the parks.

The design process included public meetings in the parks, formation of a steering committee to guide decisions, and stakeholder interviews.

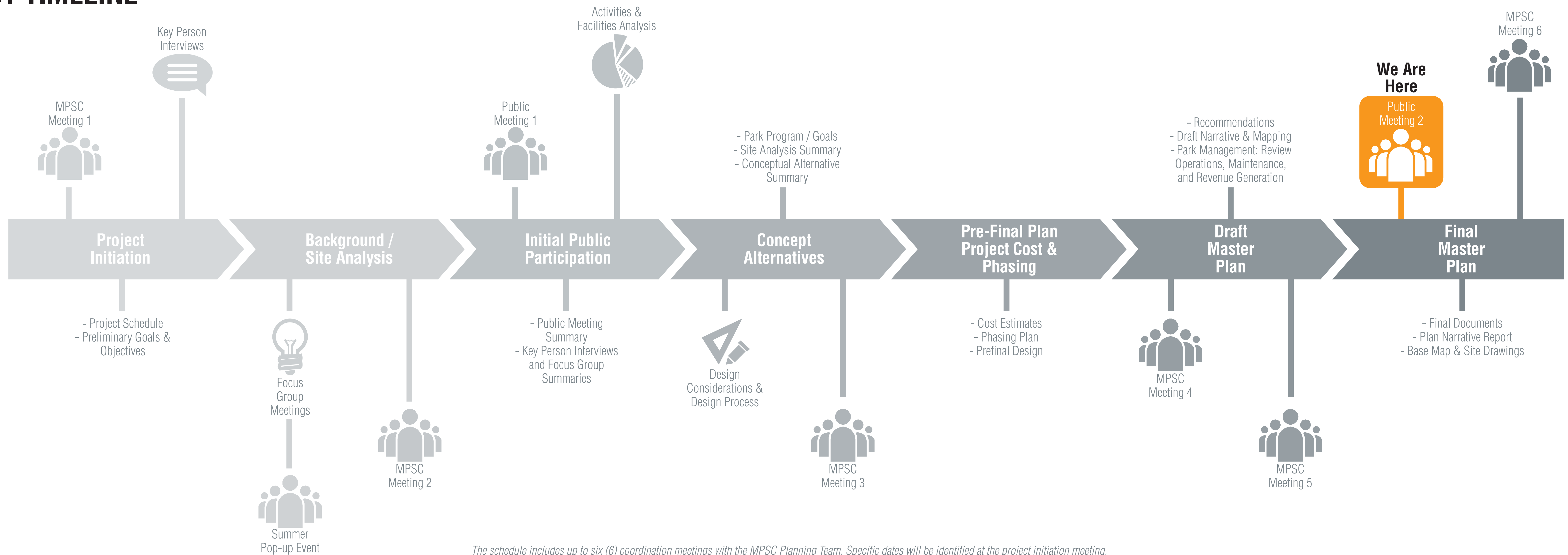
The design was shaped by information gathered about how people currently use the existing parks, how strategic investments may improve operations & experiences and how the park enhancements can improve the quality of life for the residents of the Township.

A master plan is a conceptual layout for a site. It looks at placement and relationships of facilities, plans for implementation, and acknowledgment of future growth.

- Establishes a vision for the next 20 years.
- Determines the role of the park within the committee's overall parks and recreation needs.
- Establishes a framework for how the vision can be achieved.
- Considers physical improvements and operational and management requirements.
- Establishes a guidance and policy tool for decision making.

The schedule includes up to six (6) coordination meetings with the MPSC Planning Team. Specific dates will be identified at the project initiation meeting.



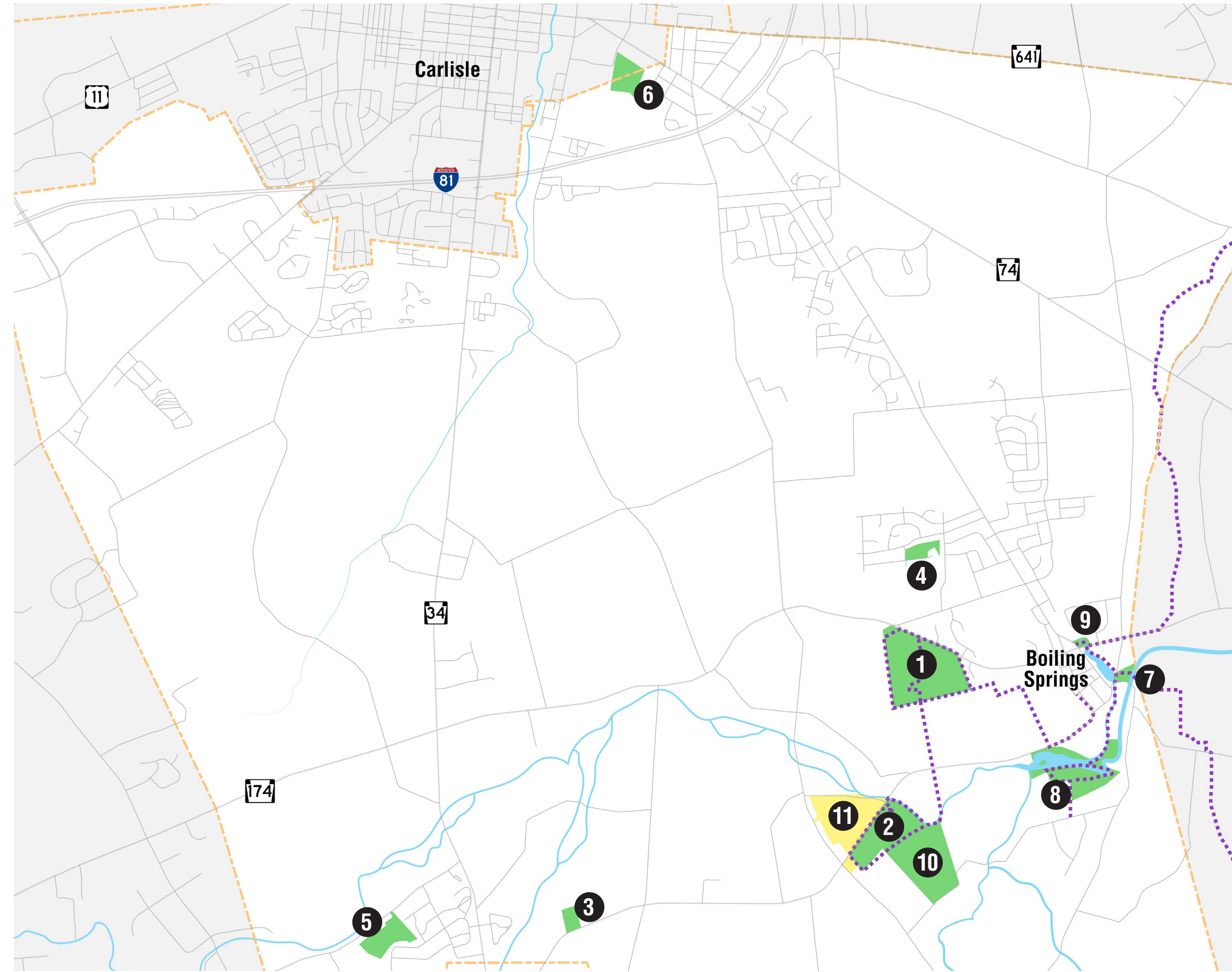
